Born in Christchurch, Martin has an impressive violin pedigree. He has won the Television New Zealand Young Musicians Competition and Australian Guarantee Corporation Young Achievers Award. Upon graduating with a Bachelor of Music degree he went to the Juilliard School in 1989 where he studied with Dorothy DeLay and Piotr Milewski. Before returning to New Zealand last year, Martin was teaching as Artist-in Residence at the University of Alberta, performing with orchestras in Canada, and Guest Concertmaster of the NZSO




